Restrictions, Obligations and University Authority: USF Policy 0-100 provides the parameters of Signatory Authority and includes restrictions and obligations for the signing of any contracts that involve (a) Debt Management, (b) International Programs, (c) Multi-State Contracts, (d) Personnel, (e) Procurement of Goods and Services, (f) Real Property, and (g) Research. Each Delegator and Delagatee is responsible for understanding the Restrictions and Obligations set forth in USF Policy 0-100.

Delegated Signatory Authority:

- 1. All Contracts with outside agencies/entities initiated by units within Athletics. Such Contracts are limited to:
 - a. Contracts, regardless of value, pertaining to intercollegiate athletic competitions; and
 - b. Contracts, regardless of value, with third-party persons or entities who facilitate intercollegiate athletic competitions, multimedia rights, athletic sponsorships, athletic advertising, or the sale of licensed athletic merchandise; and
 - c. Contracts, regardless of value, with third-party persons or entities to license the use of USF Athletics managed facilities.
- 2. All Employment Contracts with individuals to provide coaching services.

Sub-Delegation Authority: This Delegation may be Sub-Delegated.
