Restrictions, Obligations and University Authority: USF Policy 0-100 provides the parameters of Signatory Authority and includes restrictions and obligations for the signing of any contracts that involve (a) Debt Management, (b) International Programs, (c) Multi-State Contracts, (d) Personnel, Procurement of Goods and Services, (f) Real Property, and (g) Research. Each Delegator and Delagatee is responsible for understanding the Restrictions and Obligations set forth in USF Policy 0-100.

Delegated Signatory Authority:

- 1. Specific Resident and Fellow placement Contracts, Program Letters of Agreement and other cooperative education Contracts initiated by units within the USF College of Medicine, provided that this Delegation does not apply to any Contract in which there is any transfer of funds between the parties or to any Contract in which tuition is involved.
- 2. House Office Contracts issued annually to each Resident and Fellow that outline the salary, benefits, and responsibilities of a Graduate Medical Education Resident and Fellow and complies with the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) Institutional Requitements.

Sub-Delegation Authority: This Delegation may NOT be Sub-Delegated.
