Each Delegator and Delagatee is responsible for understanding the Restrictions and Obligations set forth in USF Policy 0-100.

Delegated Signatory Authority:

1. Business Associate Agreements with outside agencies/ entities where a USF Health HIP AA Covered Entity is acting as either a Business Associate or a Covered Entity as such terms are defined under the HIPAA Privacy Rule and Security Rule, including, but not limited to, 45 C.F.R. § 160.103.

Sub-Delegation Authority: This Delegation may NOT be Sub-Delegated.
