Restrictions, Obligations and University Authority: USF Policy 0-100 provides the parameters of Signatory Authority and includes restrictions and obligations for the signing of any contracts that involve (a) Debt Management, (b) International Programs, (c) Multi-State Contracts, (d) Personnel, (e) Procurement of Goods and Services, (f) Real Property, and (g) Research. Each Delegator and Delegatee is responsible for understanding the Restrictions and Obligations set forth in USF Policy 0-100.

Delegated Signatory Authority:

1. Contracts with outside agencies/entities initiated by units within USF Health, provided that such Contracts do not exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000). Such Contracts include:
 - a. Student internship and practicum agreements;
 - b. Fellowship agreements;
 - c. Faculty support agreements;
 - d. Educational outreach agreements (continuing education/distance learning);
 - e. Memoranda of understanding, cooperation, and/or affiliation agreements for student placements;
 - f. Contracts with other entities involving clinical practice by members of the academic clinical staff of the various colleges within USF Health, including any required associated HIPAA business associate agreements, and
 - g. Contracts obtaining physician and other medical provider services required to fulfill USF Health’s contractual obligations to provide care to its patient populations.
2. Fee waiver authority, for USF Health students, regarding student associated fees in accordance with USF and BOG Regulations and Policies.

Sub-Delegation Authority: This Delegation may be Sub-Delegated.
