For Future Discussion in 2020-2021

- **<u>Concentrations</u>** policy for double-dipping courses in multiple concentrations
- <u>Pre-Req Policy</u> discuss whether we should eliminate pre-reqs tied to graduate courses and have such requirements noted in the curriculum for the Catalog.
- o <u>Degree Completion</u> develop policy to encourage students to graduate on time
- o <u>Academic Dismissal</u> update language to include situations of professional misconduct.
- o **<u>Repeating a course</u>** how many times and which courses can you repeat?
- <u>Graduate Certificates</u> add language to define core (2 graduate courses) and that they should tie into a major. Consider language that limits how long a Certificate may be active if it is no longer having students complete the certificate within the five-year timeframe.
