For Future Discussion in 2020-2021

- o **Post-Consolidation Graduate Council**
- o **Doctoral Projects** - need language to address Doctoral Projects.
- o **Graduate Faculty** –revisit the policy for Graduate Faculty Definition and Affiliate Graduate Faculty definition. Policy discussions at the full Faculty Senate, Provost, and President levels.
- o **Concentrations** – policy for double-dipping courses in multiple concentrations
- o **Pre-Req Policy** – discuss if pre-reqs tied to graduate courses should be eliminated and have such requirements noted in the curriculum for the Catalog.
- o **Degree Completion** – develop policy to encourage students to graduate on time
- o **Academic Dismissal** – update language to include situations of professional misconduct.
- o **Repeating a course** – how many times and which courses can you repeat?
- o **Graduate Certificates** –define core (2 graduate courses). Consider limits for how long a Certificate may be active if no longer having students complete the certificate within the five-year timeframe.
