This move-in guide will help prepare you for the big day. Please follow our 6 Steps to Move-In when you arrive on

NOT ARRIVING AUGUST 17?

All residents must complete the Fall Move-In Sign Up form in the Housing Portal before arriving on campus for the fall semester. Two time slots are available each day: Morning (9 a.m. - 1 p.m.) or Afternoon (1 - 5 p.m.).

Residents who plan to arrive BEFORE or AFTER August 17 must also indicate their early arrival date on the Fall Move-In Sign Up form located in the Housing Portal. Students arriving early will be charged the nightly rate for their room until August 17 (the start date of the housing agreement).*

Check-in locations vary by arrival date. Please check the move-in webpage to confirm where you will check-in and receive your keys when you arrive.

Sign Up for a Move-in Time Slot

So we can best support you during your move-in experience, all residents must select a move-in appointment date and time slot in the Housing Portal before arriving on campus for the fall semester. You can choose either a Morning (9 a.m. - 1 p.m.) or Afternoon (1 - 5 p.m.) time slot.

Check in at the Marshall Student Center (MSC)

When you arrive on campus, make your way to the Marshall Student Center where our team will help you check in and get your key(s). The map included in this guide, as well as the signs around campus, will help you find your way!

Once inside the Marshall Student Center, proceed to the second-floor ballroom to check in, get your keys, and receive all necessary move-in information.

Staying Together

It is essential that every member of your group stays together. There is important information that is provided to students and families during check-in including how to get involved, how to stay connected, and where to park for unloading. Family members cannot unload belongings until their resident receives their key(s). By having the key(s) in-hand, you can avoid unnecessary delays while moving in.

Go to Your Unloading Zone

After you have checked in and received your keys, it's time to head to a 30-minute unloading zone.

Parking & Unloading

Find your residence hall and its nearest unloading zone listed on the following, page. If you leave your car in an unloading zones for longer than 30 minutes, your car may be ticketed or towed. You will not need a parking permit when unloading. At any time, a car parked in disabled spaces without a valid state disabled permit, in reserved, numbered, and labeled spaces, in unloading zones longer than 30 minutes, in unauthorized lots, or in "no parking" zones is subject to warning or citation. Routine parking enforcement resumes on Monday, August 21.

(Beacon, Endeavor, Horizon, Pinnacle, and Summit Hall) Unloading Zone: Lot 56

Long-term Parking: Lot 16, 43, or 20

Unload Your Belongings!

It's time to move-in your belongings! Please park your vehicle in a 30-minute unloading zone to unload your items. Volunteers will be near unloading zones from 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. on August 17. A limited number of carts will be available to check out during Grand Opening, but we encourage residents and families to bring their own carts or hand trucks to assist in the move-in process.



Move Your Car to a Long-Term Lot

After unloading, please move your vehicle(s) to a long-term parking lot. Long-term parking lots are indicated on the map within this move-in mailer. Families and friends without campus parking permits may park in these long-term parking spaces on Grand Opening Day while they help their student unpack and enjoy campus.



Return to Your Room and Set Up!

Now that your vehicle(s) are out of the 30-minute unloading zone, you can return to your room to take your time setting up your space.

Be prepared!

Check out these additional arrival tips as you get ready to live the Bull's life.

Know your housing assignment.

Log in to the Housing Portal, select "My Account," then "My Assignments," then "View Assignments, Roommates, and Suitemates" to view your fall/ spring housing assignment. This is also where your roommates, suitemates, or apartment-mates are listed.

Start packing!

Review the move-in checklist on our website for a list of what to bring (and what not to bring!)

Connect with your roommates, suitemates, or apartment-mates

Check in and coordinate what you will bring to campus. Things like printers, microwaves, refrigerators, and TVs can be shared!

Choose the height of your bed.

Submit an online maintenance request for your desired bed height before you arrive on campus. Keep in mind that lofting assistance may take longer after residents have moved in, so submit your request early! Residents and their families are not permitted to change the height of their bed.
