The [Inclusive and Equitable Pedagogy](#) (IEP) Course might be for you!

The IEP Course was developed by a diverse group of USF faculty and staff to support creating inclusive and equitable learning experiences across the university.

This asynchronous, online course is an introduction to incorporating inclusive and equitable practices into your class. Participants will engage with four modules, each requiring approximately 2-3 hours, to be completed over seven weeks, from **May 23 - July 11, 2022**. The course includes opportunities to reflect as well as share with colleagues.

The four modules address:

- identity and bias,
- classroom strategies and syllabi,
- difficult conversations, and
- the TRUTH Framework ([Davis-Cotton, 2021](#)).

This content seeks to empower participants to foster a culture in higher education that: recognizes identities of self and others; identifies improvement strategies that benefit all students of differing abilities and perspectives; creates new and meaningful relationships; and supports an inclusive and equitable education that empowers differences and fosters a sense of belonging.
