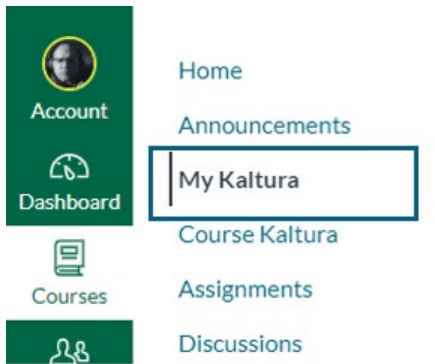


COPYING A KALTURA VIDEO

This guide will go over the steps to copy a Kaltura video.

01

Access a Canvas course and click on the **My Kaltura** link in the Course Navigation.

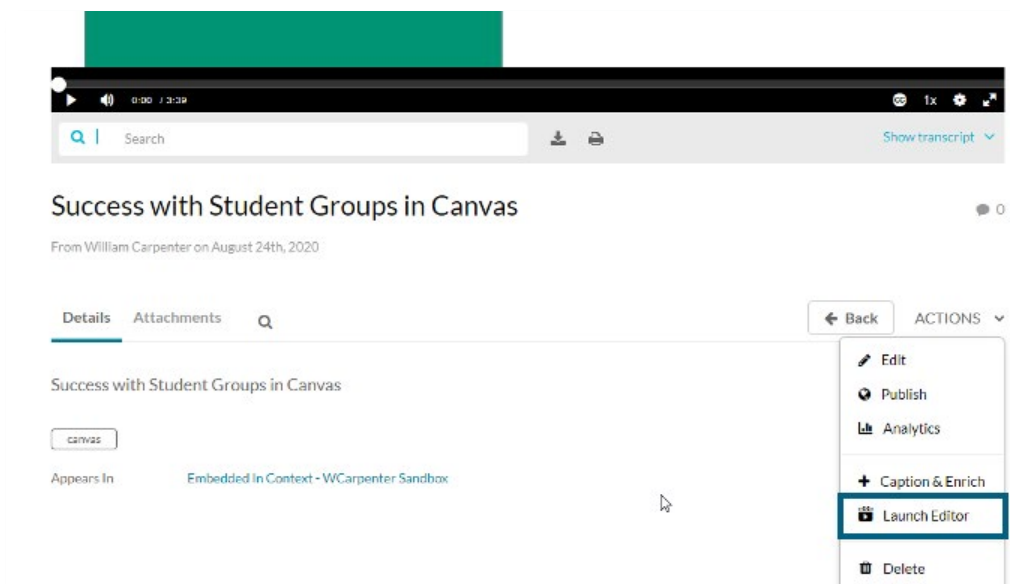

Open the video that needs to be copied.

Once the video has opened, click on the **Actions** tab, then click **Launch Editor**.



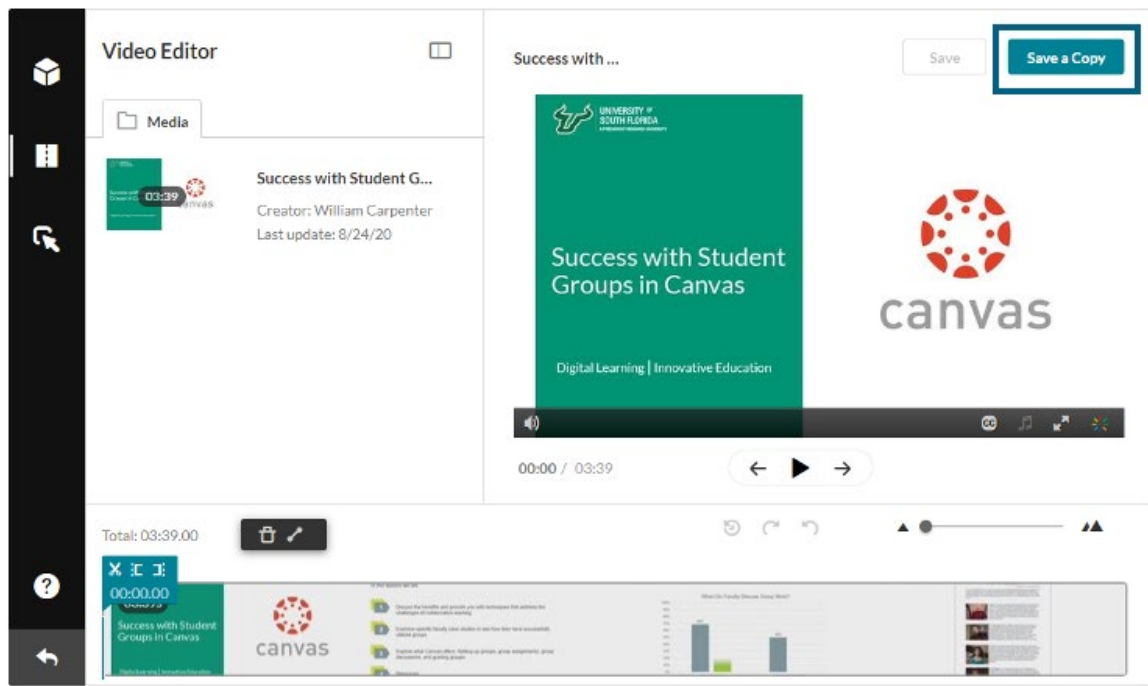
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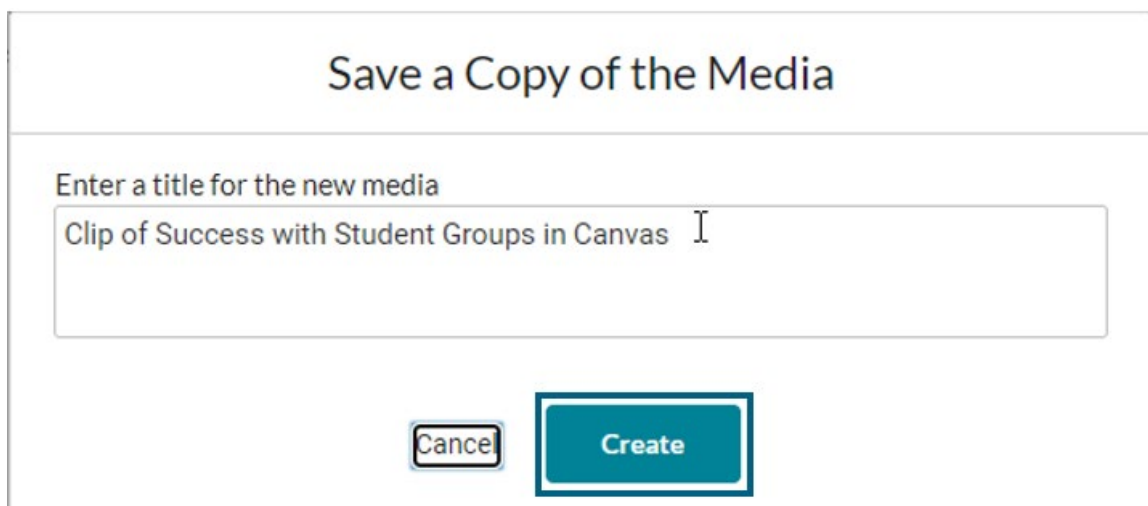

Next, select the **Save a Copy** button in the upper right-hand corner.

A Kaltura prompt will appear to rename the duplicate video, **rename** it, then select **Create**.
