Summary Notes

I. Welcome

Chair John Ramil called the meeting to order and asked the Storbeck team to take them through the meeting and their updates.

II. Implicit Bias

Shelly Storbeck and the Storbeck team reminded everyone of their implicit bias and to be mindful as they move through the discussions of the marketplace and especially prospects to keep an objective perspective.

III. Marketplace Feedback and Progress Update

The committee then heard from Lisa Solinsky on the feedback they are hearing in the marketplace and what is being said about the University of South Florida. She shared that over 200 people had been contacted for candidates, with dozens of nominations made.

The committee had questions surrounding the specific process of nominations, etc. and how contacts are made. The Storbeck team informed the committee that they had specific recommendations for who to move forward to be deeply evaluated by the committee but that the committee can always select others and make their own recommendations.

IV. Prospect Profiles

The committee then was presented with 12 prospect profiles and discussed each and organized them into various tiers.

V. Next Steps

The committee will next evaluate on a deeper level and discuss applicants to decide who to move forward with to first-round interviews with the committee before selecting finalists to meet with President Law and visit USF.
