

USF Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) Spring 2023 Virtual Training Series

USF Research Integrity & Compliance offers a comprehensive RCR training program, including both online (via CITI) and instructor-led offerings. The typical content of the instructor-led sessions includes information and presentations by experts in the field on human and animal research, safe laboratory practices, conflicts of interest, research misconduct, mentor/mentee relationships and responsibilities, authorship and publications, collaborative research, and peer review of research.

This year, USF is offering a spring 2023 RCR training series. Four (4) instructor-led sessions will be offered virtually throughout the spring. Each session will cover a distinct RCR topic and will last approximately one (1) hour. Any USF faculty member, staff, or student is welcome to attend these sessions. **Attendance at each session will satisfy one (1) credit hour for RCR training. Individuals can attend as many or as few sessions as they like. Certificates of completion for each RCR session will be issued to attendees. A combination of these training sessions will fulfill both NIH and NSF RCR training requirements.**
