GENERAL POLICY

- For any questions or concerns regarding any of the following policies and rules please contact our Sports Programs office at (813) 974-4449 or rec-imsports@usf.edu. Or stop by our office, REC 107, Monday – Friday 10am-5pm.
- All participants must check in with a Sports Programs supervisor, through the USF Esports Discord, with either their USF ID card or driver's license. The USF ID or Driver's License must have a clear name, UID number and picture. No other forms of identification may be used to check in.
- All officially enrolled students and Faculty and Staff members with an active Recreation and Wellness membership at the University of South Florida are eligible to play. For further eligibility guidelines please reference the IM Handbook, found on the USF Recreation and Wellness website.
- **Game time is forfeit time.** Teams should be ready to play at the scheduled game time. It is beneficial to have your team arrive 15-20 minutes early to ensure that games start on time and that forfeits be avoided.
- In order to plan and schedule matches all participants must be members of the USF Esports Discord as well as be registered through FusionIM.
- All match scores must be reported through FusionIM.
- All players must play in the division associated with their highest account in-game rank. Any players found utilizing a lower rank alternate account will be disqualified.

SPORT CLUB PARTICIPANTS

- For sports with more than 4 players, only 3 sport club participants may be on the same team in the same sport. For sports with 4 players or fewer, only 2 sport club participants may be on the same team in the same sport. A sport club participant is defined as a student who has appeared on a home or away match roster within the past 365 days from the day of the intramural game. A team is allowed to have only 2 or 3 total club members, regardless of gender, dependent on the size of the sport. This rule only applies to sport club members whose sport is the same or in close relation to the intramural being offered (i.e. volleyball club(s) for volleyball intramural or rocket league club for rocket league intramural)

SPORTSMASHIP

- All players will have a sportsmanship rating associated with their behavior during intramural matches.
- Following each game both teams will be given a sportsmanship rating from 1-6 based on chat monitoring and potential reports from teams following their matches.

- Factors which can affect sportsmanship rating can include in game toxicity and using chat features to attack opponents.
- Players are required to have an average sportsmanship rating of 4 in order to qualify for playoffs.

RULES

- Game Mode: Warzone Duos
- Teams will play a total of 5 warzone games gaining points through either kills or placement
- Following the conclusion of all 5 games teams will submit screenshots of their most recent 5 games with the first starting at/around the assigned IM match time.
- All teams must submit screenshots in order for points to be certified and assigned.
- If screenshots are not sent then the match slot will be recorded as a forfeit.
- One point will be awarded per kill per player.
- We will use cod Tracker to make sure ONLY 5 MATCHES ARE PLAYED. If more than 5 are played, it will be an automatic forfeit
- Disconnects, dev errors, or being killed by hackers may result in an additional game IF proof is provided (screenshot of dev error)
- Placement points will be awarded per match according to the following chart
