

New Sport Club at USF Application

Steps to Create a New Sport Club:

- 1. Complete this application.
- 2. Submit the application to: rec-sportclubs@usf.edu.
- 3. The proposed club shall meet the following criteria:
 - Must be a Sport or an Esport.
 - Must have a minimum of ten (10) interested, actively enrolled students.
 - It shall NOT duplicate the style of an existing sport club at the University of South Florida - Tampa Campus.
 - It shall have a reasonable method of participating in at least one competition/ seminar/clinic with non-USF individuals/groups per calendar year.
 - Use of National Governing Body is strongly encouraged.
 - o It shall be financially practical to start and sustain over time.
 - o It shall be safe and practical to conduct the activity to practice in order to compete.
- 4. Sport Clubs <u>must</u> become Registered Student Organizations with the <u>Center for Leadership and Civic Engagement</u> (CLCE) on campus.
- 5. The Sports Programs Staff will request a meeting with the interested students to review the submitted application.
- 6. Following the meeting, the Sports Programs Staff will determine if the applicant(s) meets the parameters of the program to be approved or denied.
- 7. Once a determination is reached, the applicant(s) will receive an email notice with an outcome letter confirming the status of the request.
 - a. If the request is denied, the applicant(s) can submit an appeal <u>one week</u> from receiving the official notice.
 - b. The applicant(s) are to submit the written appeal to rec-sportclubs@usf.edu.
- 8. If the request is approved, the applicant(s) will need to successfully complete the 8-week probationary period to become fully activated.
- 9. Once the club becomes activated, the group will need to maintain the outlined requirements of the recreational/instructional classification tier to avoid possible reclassification *or* deactivation.
