(1) A governing body is defined as an official organization that formulates rules for a sport and has regulatory or sanctioning functions over the sport

(2) Active membership is defined as regularly participating in club activities, and will be recorded using travel rosters and membership audits

(3) The Past-President/Vice President officer position will not be required until the 2016-2017 school year

(4) A collegiate league is defined as an association of college teams that compete against one another using an established schedule. The results of the individual competitions are used to name an overall champion and/or to determine eligibility for post-season competition.

(5) If a collegiate league is not available for a club to join, this requirement will be waived if all other criteria have been met for at least 2 consecutive years.

(6) Competition will be defined by the club's governing body (single game, tournament, etc.)

(7) A seminar/clinic is defined as an event where participants receive instruction or training in their sport, for the purpose of skill improvement

(8) A practice is defined as physically training in your sport collectively with your club. At least 1/3 of your active membership must be present.
