

- All foods brought to the Bull Market must comply with the Hillsborough County Department of Health regulations & University Environmental Health & Safety regulations.
- All groups that wish to bring food to the Bull Market must fill out a food release form, have food approved one week before attending the Bull Market, and bring valid receipt day of Bull Market.
- Student organizations and non for profit are allow to have fundraisers involving food with approval by the market staff.
- Foods permitted at the Market must be prepackaged and/or prepared under proper conditions as outlined by the Department of Health and Safety.
- Any food that is cooked or prepared at home are prohibited at the Bull Market.
- Beverages given out or sold at the market must not be a competitor of Coca-Cola products.
- Food requiring refrigeration or heating must follow University Environmental Health & Safety regulations.
