

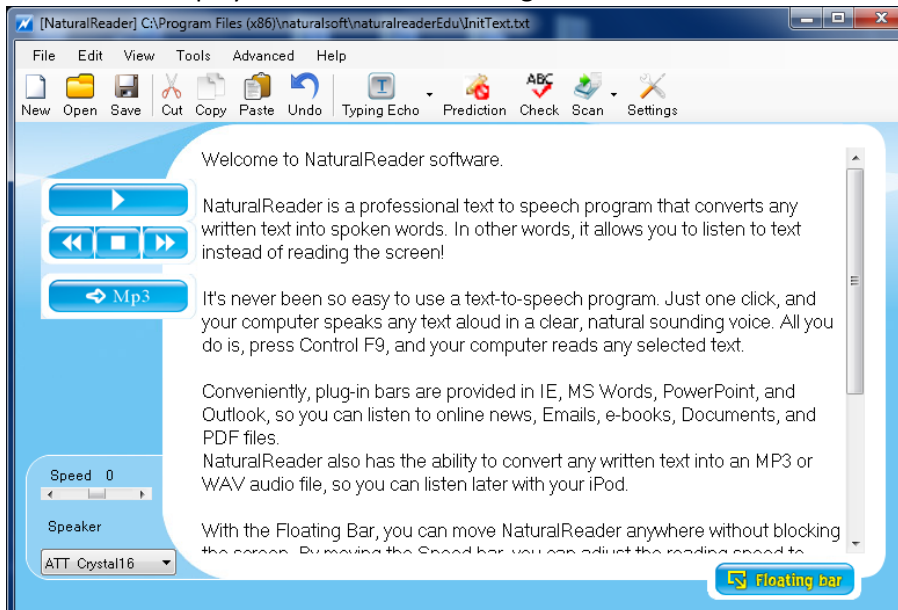


How to create MP3 file using NaturalReader

1. Open NaturalReader
2. Open the document/file to be used in the conversion
3. Select and copy the text from the document
4. Paste the text from the document into NaturalReader
5. Select the speed (0 is the default speed) and speaker voice (Heather US English, Ryan US English, etc.)
6. Click the MP3 button
7. Choose a file name and destination for the file
8. Select Convert Now to start conversion

Note: For large files additional preferences will need to be selected after selecting Convert Now

9. Choose the audio quality. This will affect the amount of time the file takes to convert as well as the size of the file
10. Click next, the advanced settings will then ask if the file will remain as one file or be split into multiple files
11. The last step will provide tag information for the file
12. Click Convert to start the process
13. After the conversion is finished, open the file folder, then double click to open the file
14. Click on the play button to start listening
