- Collaborated with SUS Insurance Broker to implement 22-23 Insurance Plan
- Continued to strengthen collaboration with Counseling Center & Center for Student Well-Being
- Continued to strengthen Behavioral Health Services through case management and campus resources
- Researched opportunities for expanding Behavioral Health Services
- Promoted and supported implementation of TimelyCare to expand virtual Behavioral Health Services
- Expanded collaborative relationship with Athletics/Spirit Squads including assuming primary care and pharmaceutical services
- Continued to administer COVID-19 testing for symptomatic and asymptomatic patients
- Continued partnership with Housing and Residential Education to diagnosis and monitor students in isolation
- Expanded and promoted clinic at Sarasota-Manatee campus
- Promoted clinic at CAMLS in partnership with USF Health and held an open house for medical students
- Expanded Jotform (HIPAA compliance custom online platform) access as a communicative tool for students and patients to ask questions

- Increased Influenza "Flu" vaccination administration by 15% to support the preventative health and wellbeing of the entire USF community

- Feed-A-Bull food pantry served 200% more students through continued promotion, visibility, and education on food insecurity

- Implemented final phase of Wellness Center, including expanded facilities for urgent care, primary medicine, behavioral healthcare, registration compliance, and health insurance enrollment
- Created a robust marketing plan promoting the new facility
- Moved into Student Health & Wellness Center and became operational at new facility in May 2023
- Held satellite Influenza clinics at St. Petersburg, Sarasota-Manatee, USF Health's The WELL, Juniper-Poplar Residential Hall, and CAMLS to immunize students, faculty, and staff
- Held Influenza clinics at all 3 campus Benefit Fairs to immunize faculty & staff and recoup cost of vaccine
- Distributed 90,000 (100% of donated health items) free at-home COVID test kits on 4 campuses: Tampa, St. Petersburg, Sarasota-Manatee, and Downtown Tampa

Strategic Initiatives





90,000 test kits were donated by Verséa Diagnostics to facilitate community health. Students, Faculty, and Staff received all 90,000 at-home COVID Self-swab Test Kits at no cost. The iHealth kits were available on all 4 campuses, distributed in the student centers, and by Tampa Housing & Residential Education through the campus mail centers.

Student Health & Wellness Center

In 2021, USF broke ground on what would become the future home of Student Health. As of June 2022, the Student Health & Wellness Center started to take shape with the foundation as proof of our commitment to health. In May 2023, we moved into our three-story 47,000 square foot center. Our state-of-the-art Student Health & Wellness Center is dedicated to improving student wellness, so that students can strengthen their learning experiences both inside and outside the classroom. Beginning Summer of 2023, students were be able to receive General Medical, Primary Care, Urgent Care, and Specialty Services, some of which are listed below.




Student-designed patient waiting areas










Clinic usage by Gender



Insured 80% Self-Pay 20%








Campus & Clinical Partners
