Telebehavioral Healthcare is the delivery of behavioral health services using interactive audio and visual electronic systems where the therapists and the patient are not in the same physical location. The interactive electronic systems used in Telebehavioral Healthcare incorporate network and software security protocols to protect the confidentiality of patient information and audio and visual data. These protocols include measures to safeguard the data and to aid in protecting against intentional or unintentional corruption.
