REMEMBER

- **Summer credit hours are “stackable”:** This means that, on the dates that semesters overlap, you can combine the credit hours from both semesters to reach full time status. *For example, an Undergraduate student enrolled in 3 credit hours online in Summer A and 6 credit hours in person in Summer C will be considered FULL TIME for the entire Summer A semester and then drop down to $\frac{3}{4}$ TIME for the rest of the Summer C semester*
- **Post 9/11 GI Bill Students ONLY:** you must be enrolled in AT LEAST ONE CREDIT HOUR IN PERSON to receive your full housing stipend (if you are enrolled full time). If you are enrolled full time in all online classes, you will receive half the national average for your housing stipend per month
