The following is additional information for the Social Work major:

- The School of Social Work has a SEPARATE APPLICATION PROCESS from that of the University of South Florida. When you are enrolled in SOW 3203, the Advisor from the School of Social Work will speak with the class about the eligibility requirements, the admissions procedure and the BSW program. You will have the opportunity to ask questions and discuss any concerns you might have. The application will be emailed to you after her class presentation. You may submit it electronically or it can be printed and turned in to the School of Social Work cc/Raymond Budd 13301 Bruce B. Downs Blvd., MHC 1400 Tampa, FL 33612.
- Students are admitted to begin the BSW program twice yearly. They may be admitted for Fall or Spring semester. The application deadline for Fall semester is July 1st. The application deadline for the Spring semester is October 15th. There are no summer admissions.
- All applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.75
- All pre-requisite courses must have been passed with a C or better. As long as all pre-requisite courses are complete or *IN-PROGRESS*, the student may apply.
- Students are admitted as part of a cohort, and will take the courses in a specific sequential order (listed above).

Program Structure:

The BSW Program is full time/day time available only on the Tampa USF campus. The Social Work major is structured to be completed in 3 semesters (with no summer classes). During the Fall and Spring semesters, courses are scheduled a maximum of 3 days on campus. In the Final semester, students are in their field placement Monday through Thursday, 32 hours weekly and classes meet on Fridays. If there are exceptional circumstances, students may apply for a split field placement. This extends the BSW major to 4 semesters. 16 hours of field is completed in the 3rd semester and the remaining field hours are done in the final (4th) semester. The split field option allows students with extensive work or family commitments the ability to obtain the BSW degree.
