### The following is additional information for the Art History major:

- The BA degree in Art History is considered open admission; therefore, a portfolio review is not required. Prospective students need only complete the application for the University of South Florida and be accepted.
- Students pursuing the BA degree in Art History must prove foreign language proficiency before graduating from USF. Students may prove the foreign language proficiency the following ways:
  - Through the College Level Examination Program (CLEP)
  - By transferring the foreign language from a college or university
  - By completing two semesters of the same foreign language at USF
  - Sitting for the foreign language placement exam (contact the Department of World Languages for information about the Foreign Language placement exam at 813-974-2538)
- The minimum grades for Art History major courses is a "C" grade.
- Students pursuing the BA degree in Art History must acquire at least a 2.0 GPA to graduate.
- Fifty percent of the Art History major courses must be taken at the University of South Florida.
- Students who plan to pursue the Master of Arts degree in Art History are encouraged to prove in either French or German.
