Oscar welcomed everyone to the UGC meeting.

a. Course Change Accuracy - Oscar Bernard

Oscar reminded the Council that course changes need to utilize the correct forms and proposers need to ensure to list every change. He used the example of a proposer using a course change form, but failing to mention that said course was also undergoing a change in credit hours. This would also impact the course's rigor, and thus how the course is certified.

b. USF Policy on Curricular Offerings - Oscar Bernard

Oscar brought to attention an update to the USF policy on curricular offerings and asked for the Council's vote mainly regarding the following section: "Academic Certificates should be a minimum of 9 core credit hours and must be completed while the student is an enrolled degree-seeking undergraduate student. Undergraduate Academic Certificates may consist of courses that are part of a major or courses that are created outside of a major, but all credits counting towards the certificate must be unique to the certificate (i.e., a student cannot use the same course to meet both major and certificate requirements)."

He mentioned how there is some disagreement amongst certain colleges, wherein some prefer that the minimum core credit hours be changed so 6, rather than 9; but mentioned how stakeholders and most colleges prefer it stay with the written 9. Oscar called the policy

to vote. It was **APPROVED**, 12 to 1 with no abstentions. The result will be sent to the provost for review.
