The following is additional information for the Professional and Technical Communication major:

- Internships are available and highly recommended for students to incorporate into years three or four of the degree.
- This major does require two semesters of foreign language to be completed in a college or university setting.
- If a student is already proficient in a foreign language, they need to discuss testing out of the foreign language with an advisor or the USF World Languages Department.
- Students will be required to compile a portfolio of their work throughout the degree program. It is completed and presented during the capstone course.
- The requirements for the Professional and Technical Communication degree allow for open electives of any ENC or ENG course, as well as electives outside the major. Students are encouraged to use these credits to pursue a minor or certificate that will broaden and enrich their major studies. Students may elect to pursue any minor.
- Students must have at least a 2.00 GPA before graduation.
- Students are recommended to continually gain relevant experience for their intended career and/or graduate school path. This might include becoming involved in volunteering or research, completing an internship, or being active on campus with an activity or organization relevant to future goals.
- Students can use electives that are outside of the English department to pursue a minor in a different area of study.
