

The following is additional information for the Health Care Administration B.S. major:

1. The major is a total of 39 credit hours.
2. A minimum C- is required in major core courses.
3. Our graduates qualify for positions as administrators for hospitals and other healthcare facilities.
4. Our graduates can also take the examination to become licensed nursing home and assisted living community administrators.
5. The internship (GEY 4945, 9 academic credit hours/650 hours), scheduled after successful completion of all major prerequisites and all but one of the required courses, is intended to prepare students for positions in nursing home administration.
6. Students who do not wish to complete the full-time internship (GEY 4945) will need to choose 3 undergraduate courses/9 credit hours of electives. Students will need to receive permission from the Undergraduate Director and meet with the Academic Advisor to decide which classes best fit their goals, at least a semester in advance.
