GLOBAL TRAVEL SUPPORT AND NEW INSURANCE POLICY

USF has signed a service a new international support (International SoS) and international health and safety insurance policy (Gallagher is the broker and insurance is from Zurich).

Wider network of dedicated health and security professionals on-call around the world allowing for greater pre-travel advice, as well as monitoring of active medical, mental health, and security cases.

- Dedicated academic (vs. corporate) call number and chat options make it easier to get support.
- Stronger in-house security and risk services including traveler tracking (GPS monitoring attached to the ISoS app), push notifications to travelers regarding civil unrest, strikes, weather alerts etc., electronic check-ins etc.
- Additional mental health counseling services.
- Robust learning materials for travelers with 40+ modules to help prepare USF travelers for a safe and healthy trip. There are specific modules for student travelers, as well as modules focusing on identity-based security concerns, cybersecurity, avoiding kidnapping, malaria, etc.
- Insurance policy includes Trip Delay and Trip Interruption and a higher threshold of coverage (\$500K)

- At this point last year, we had 833 FTIC applications. While the volume continues to increase, we are seeing a lot of apps from Africa and Eastern Europe which will not complete or yield.
- We are proactively cancelling students immediately who are not taking SAT.
- We are still facing a lot of students applying via Common App and not realizing we are not a test optional school.
