### **Travel Signatures**

Students planning to travel outside the U.S. for the November or December holidays should check their I-20 on page two for a valid travel signature. If the travel signature is dated November 20, 2022 or earlier, it is time for a fresh signature. Log into iStart to access the Travel Signature eform. Be sure to give staff at least 5 days to process.

#### **University Holiday Closures**

The university and our office will be closed on Friday, November 10 for Veteran's Day and on Thursday, November 23 and Friday, November 24 for Thanksgiving Day.

#### **Winter Break Closure**

The university will be closed for Winter Break beginning Thursday, December 21, 2023 through Monday, January 1, 2024. iStart eforms will not be processed during Winter Break. Students should finalize all eforms by Wednesday, December 13, 2023 at 11:59pm, if they need to be processed in 2023.

### **Holiday Scams**

The winter holidays are a common time for scams especially in the form of a suspicious phone call or email. Here are a few things you can do to protect yourself:

- **Guard your personal information.** Do not give out birth date, Social Security Number, or any other identifying information to someone over the phone or email.
- Don't be afraid to hang up. If an individual asks for information or payment, it's okay to hang up.
- **Don't offer to pay a debt with a gift card.** Government officials will never ask for payment over the phone or email. Especially not with gift cards!
- Government officials will not use fear to encourage a person to complete a process. If a phone call or email threatens to arrest or deport a person unless they pay a fee, hang up!
- Most government offices still send paper mail. Regular paper mail is the most common way that government
  agencies contact people about immigration status or taxes. Suspicious mail can be show to our office for
  verification.
- **Report scams**. Let our office know about the scam! Also report to the <u>Federal Trade Commission</u>, and the organization or institution from which the scammer claims to be representing. Most government agencies have a section on their website about reporting fraudulent activity.
- Contact OIS about suspicious phone calls, email, or if you've fallen victim to a scam. We can help you, and reporting scams helps us protect other international students from dangerous or expensive scams, too.

## **USF Academic Reminders**

## **Spring 2024 Course Registration**

Official registration for courses for spring semester begins October 30<sup>th</sup>. F-1 students should select mostly in-person courses at their home campus. Undergraduate F-1 students should plan to enroll in 12 credits hours and graduate F-1 students should plan to enroll in 9 credit hours. F-1 students are restricted to counting one 3 credit hour online course towards their full-time enrollment. Students who are completing their academic program and graduating in Spring 2024 can complete the Reduced Course Load eform in iStart if they need less than full-time courses to complete the program.

#### **Excess Credit Hours**

Students should not postpone graduation or add additional excess credit hours for the purposes of engaging in internships or post graduation work.

## **USF Home Campus**

F-1 students are required to take the majority of their courses at their USF Home Campus. Our office will begin running an alert in Spring 2024 and will contact students who do not follow this rule.

We recommend that students check carefully to determine the campus connected to online courses. Taking courses at multiple campuses does not allow a student to take additional online courses. F-1 students are restricted to counting one 3 credit hour online courses towards their full-time enrollment.

## **Winter Session**

The <u>Winter Session</u> occurs during Winter Break and consists of online courses. While F-1 students can take courses during winter session, they need to be aware that these courses count towards the Spring semester and appear on their transcript as Spring semester courses. <u>This means that students who take a winter session online course will need to take all face-to-face courses for Spring semester.</u>
